COMPLETE TOURNAMENT RULES

FORMAT

You will participate in a series of three games. After each game, you will play against a different opponent. In the first round special consideration will be paid to avoid pairing players from the same league. Pairing will otherwise be done randomly. After that, in each round the two players in 1st and 2nd place (based on their points for coaching) will play each other, the players in 3rd and 4th place will play each other; the players in 5th and 6th place will play each other, and so on.... You will play a different opponent each round and shouldn't play the same person twice. Should this happen accidentally, see an official and a

referee will step in and sort things out so that the players face fresh opponents of a suitable caliber. After three rounds of play the top point earner will be declared the winner.

ROSTERS

The cost of living in the Tri-State area is high, so coaches have 1,200,000 crowns with which to build their Blood Bowl teams. Coaches must CLEARLY indicate on their rosters what skills, if any, they have purchased (see Skill Advancement below). This money can also be used to purchase a Halfling Master Chef and/or Bribes (standard LRB6 pricing for both).

Races permitted to compete:

Amazon, Chaos, Chaos Dwarf, Chaos Pact, Dark Elf, Dwarf, Elf, Goblin, Halfling, High Elf, Human, Khemri, Lizardmen, Necromantic, Norse, Nurgle's Rotter, Ogre, Orc, Skaven, Slann, Undead, Underworld, Vampire, Wood Elf

UNION CONCESSIONS

In order to arrange for this year's event, certain local union bosses "requested" that several of their, um, "Family members" be allowed to participate. At the beginning of each match, each coach will roll to see which Family member will join his or her team for that game. The Family member will leave the team between rounds and a new Family member will be rolled for the next game. The union bosses have requested a certain amount of anonymity, so the specifics surrounding the Family members will only be released on the day of the tournament. And I ain't sayin' nuthin' cuz I ain't no snitch!!

RAISING THE DEAD

The extra player is added during the match and is removed from the roster after the match. A zombie cannot be raised if the team already has a full roster of 16 players.

TIMERS AND ILLEGAL PROCEDURE

No timers will be used and Illegal Procedure may not be called during the tournament as it is indicative of having sadly inadequate manhood. If a player forgets to move his turn marker, a real man would just politely remind him. Da Ref will ensure games run to schedule, by hook or by crook!

DEATH AND INJURIES

All rosters reset after each match, thus any seriously injured or deceased players will be back for your next match. Lucky for you, pansy elf!

SKILLS

If coaches do not spend all of their gold crowns on players, cheerleaders, bribes and such like, they may opt to "upgrade" some players instead based upon the costs listed below. All purchased skills MUST be clearly marked on the roster and all rosters will be checked by Da Ref prior to the tournament kicking-off...

Normal Skill – 20,000 gold crowns

Doubles Skill – 40,000 gold crowns

+1MA/AV – 50,000 gold crowns

+1ST/AG – 60,000 gold crowns

No single player may have more than 2 "upgrades" in total.

No single player may have more than one Stat increase.

KICK OFF TABLE

The LRB 6.0 Kick-Off Table will be used.

TOURNAMENT POINTS

Win = 3 points

Tie = 1 Point

Loss = 0 Points

PAINTING

There will be a painting award handed out to the best painted team on each day of the event, however

scores for painting will NOT be given and therefore do not affect the result of the tournament.

SPORTSMANSHIP

If you don't know how to behave in a civilized way, Da Ref will teach you a lesson in manners which you won't forget. Surgeons would take hours to get the expression off your face, so play nice!

AWARDS

There will be a prize for Tournament Champion, Best Painted Team, Most Brutal, Most Touchdowns, and the humiliation of the "Line of Scrimmage" award for turning up just to get beaten down.

THE NAF

The NAF is an international association of players dedicated to Blood Bowl – Games Workshop's game of fantasy football. This tournament is NAF sanctioned, which means that any matches you play against another NAF member will count towards your overall ranking. It is worth noting that matches against non-NAF members do not count towards your ranking as there is no way of judging the quality of an 'unknown' opponent.
